The 2020 National Trans Visibility March will Continue the BlackOut Racism Virtual Event Series!

WASHINGTON, D.C., June 2020 -- The National Trans Visibility March's recent virtual event, BlackOut Racism, reached over 20,000 people on June 13th. "The feedback was so overwhelming that we decided to continue the series until the March happening on October 3rd," remarks this year's National Strategy Director, Dani Farrell, "it's important that we keep these conversations going and the National Trans Visibility March believes it's our responsibility to provide a platform to do so!"

In July, the National Trans Visibility March will host the next installment of BlackOut Racism. NTVM will bring back the co-moderator's from Real Deal: The Trans Experience; Hope Giselle, trans activist, author, and NTVM's Director of External Affairs along with Tatiana Williams, LGBTQ advocate and Co-Founder/Executive Director of Transinclusive Group, Inc. The panels for the July event will focus on voting and conversations with non-Black allies on how their contributions can shape the future of the current movements.

This past week, NTVM has launched the "We Can't Breathe Either" campaign, which shines a very necessary spotlight on the recent killings and violence against the Black trans community, especially Black trans women. "We have been quiet, we have been polite, but now is the time to demand justice, equality, and safety for our Black trans siblings!" says Marissa Miller, last year's National Strategy Director and this year's Director of Fundraising & Operations.
